Guideline for the Appointment of Examiners: Part 2 Examinations in Clinical Radiology

Any Fellow of the College who meets the selection criteria may nominate as an Examiner for Part 2 of the Clinical Radiology examinations.

Criteria for the Selection of Examiners

An Examiner must:

- be a Fellow of the College:
- have held the FRANZCR for at least five years;
- be actively involved in teaching and/or training in Australia, New Zealand or Singapore;
- be prepared to undertake training as an examiner; and
- be an active participant in the College's CPD program.

Procedure for Application as an Examiner

- 1. An application from a Fellow should be accompanied by:
 - a. A completed application form
 - b. The Fellow's CV (no more than 4 pages)
 - c. A nomination form with signature from three Fellows:
 - i. Two of the three nominators must be either current or past FRANZCR viva examiners
 - ii. Individual Reference from each nominator
 - d. A 200-word statement on 'Suitability for the examiner role?'
- 2. The application including supporting documentation, should be forwarded to the Senior Projects Officer, Exams via exams@ranzcr.com.
- The application will then be considered by the Clinical Radiology Examination Review Panel (CRERP) for approval.
- 4. The application will then be forwarded to the Clinical Radiology Education & Training Committee (CRETC) for noting.
- 5. After noting at the CRETC, the applicant is appointed as a provisional examiner.
- 6. The applicant will then be invited to observe at least one oral examination session in their subspecialty area(s).
- 7. The Provisional Examiner will examine the next series with a Senior Examiner.
- 8. After successful Observer and Provisional Examiner sessions, the Chief Censor may appoint as a RANZCR Examiner.

Duties of Examiners

Examiners are expected to:

- participate in the examinations in line with the Code of Conduct;
- be a good communicator;
- keep confidential all details of an individual's performance in the examination;
- attend the Deputy Chief Censor's orientation briefing;
- attend the Debriefing Meeting following the Viva examinations; and
- be willing to actively participate in providing MCQs and providing appropriate films for the Film Reporting aspect of the written examinations.

Applicant examines at next exam series with senior examiner, if scheduled.



Chief Censor to confer with Lead Examiner in the subspecialty. Lead Examiner to make recommendation to Chief Censor.



Following recommendation from Lead Examiner, Chief Censor appoints as an Examiner.
